The project will create a robust STEM ecosystem that creates critical thinkers, problem-solvers, and next generation innovators through MANAK in NVS and Stem For Girls India schools. American India Foundation will be implementing the project with the support of IBM.

Key Responsibilities:

The Project Lead will manage the team and coordinate with all the states for the implementation of projects under Vigyan Jyoti. The person in this position will also mentor students to submit ideas under MANAK. They will be responsible for interacting with knowledge partners and managing workshops across the states.

The responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

Project Management:

- Manage the team responsible for implementing projects under Vigyan Jyoti across states.
- Plan and execute an effective project management and communication plan and ensuring.
- Ideate activities and workshop for the project along with State Project Managers.
- Coordinating with knowledge partners and planning for science workshops.
- Work closely with Monitoring and Evaluation team to ensure tracking and reporting of project activities and identifying development areas within the project.
- Managing the data and expenses of conducting workshops and camps.

- Assist in the administrative tasks related to the project.

Strategy and Communication:

- Develop strong relations with key stakeholders involved in the project to ensure the development of a good network within the states.
- Work closely with the communications team to create an advocacy and a social media outreach plan for the project.
- Document project activities and status reports by gathering and analyzing relevant data.
- Create written and visual content, including presentations and videos, for Vigyan Jyoti and contribute to the knowledge management team.
- Conduct research for identifying gaps and solutions for the projects under Vigyan Jyoti.

Qualifications and Experience:

B.Tech/Master's in science disciplines with 4-6 years of work experience preferably within the Ed-Tech sector. 2 years of work experience in a management role is preferred.
